Scope Of Service:

- Roadways: Either on-demand "Per Push" or Seasonal/Automatic Plowing of neighborhood streets when snowfall accumulation and the following criteria is met:
 - On Demand service occurs on a case-by-case basis when authorization is granted by the Association's Project Manager based on snow accumulation and other prevailing conditions. The contractor responds to calls for service within a specified time frame.
 - Automatic service is triggered by the contractor when local weather stations indicate the Detroit area has received snowfalls equal to a pre-approved amount.
 The contractor responds to calls for service within a specified time frame.
- On-demand follow-up salting of roadways
- Intersections: Clearing of intersections when plowing exceeds 12"
- Optional Sidewalk clearing
